## What should I expect from here?

- 1) Note: This may begin regardless of any state inspection you have ever had in the past
- 2) E-mail me at [RadiationPhysics@comcast.net](mailto:RadiationPhysics@comcast.net) or call me at 615-268-4345.
- 3) We'll work out an inspection time and date.
- 4) I will need your "X-ray" folder (Specifically, I need is a copy of your registrations and a copy of your most recent bill from the state). If you can't find them. I can help you secure a copy from the state.
- 5) I will review your paperwork and take several shots on each piece of equipment. I try to fit this in on your lunch-break.
- 6) When I am finished, I will provide you with a new X-ray folder filled with your essential documents to maintain. I will also provide you with a report for your records.
- 7) In most cases, I will be able to e-file the report directly to the state on your behalf once the inspection is complete.
- 8) I will collect my fees after I finish.
- 9) Post inspection: I send out e-newsletters about 5 times a year to help you stay up with new regulations, etc. So you will hear from me a lot over the next 4 years.
- 10) Post Inspection: If you add or replace equipment or offices during the next 4 years, you must call me ASAP! The state requires that all such changes be inspected within a strict timeline.
- 11) Post Inspection: If you make no such changes, I will contact you 4 years from now and we will start the whole process over again.
- 12) Every March 17<sup>th</sup>, you will pay the state 18% of their fees!
